

PARKING VOUCHERS FOR THE CHURCH STREET DECK

The New Brunswick Parking Authority has made vouchers available for those who must park in the Lower Church Street Parking Deck next to the church grounds. The vouchers will allow you to exit the parking deck for free. Please note that these vouchers are one-time use vouchers good for up to eight hours of parking and cannot be reused.

To park at the Church Street Deck:

1. Get a ticket when entering the deck.
2. Pick up a voucher at Christ Church.
3. Either go to the pay-on-foot kiosks, or proceed to the gate when you are ready to leave the deck.

- a. To pay at the kiosk, follow the instructions for inserting the ticket you received when entering the deck, and then put your Christ Church voucher under the "Scan Barcode" slot to pay for the parking. You can then exit the deck with the ticket that the machine will give back to you.



- b. To exit directly at the gate follow the instructions below.

IMPORTANT: WHEN EXITING, USE THE GATE TO THE RIGHT, NOT THE ONE NEXT TO THE OLD CASHIER'S BOOTH.

1. When exiting the deck, put the ticket that you got when entering the deck in the ticket slot in the machine that operates the gate.
2. Put the voucher that you got at the church, barcode up, under the red laser light at the bottom right hand corner of the machine.



- Tip: when putting the voucher under the laser reader, make sure it is face up with "Christ Church" at the top.*
3. The gate will rise and allow you to exit the deck.

PLEASE NOTE: *If you have a problem with using the voucher at the gate, please press the assistance button on the left, or call Parking Authority security at 732.667.8100, and someone will assist you in exiting the deck.*
